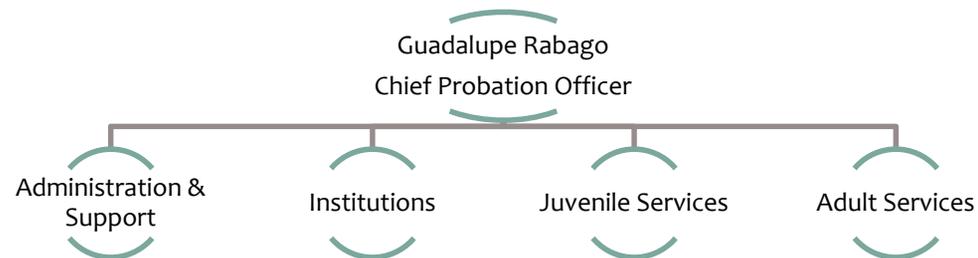

- Develop process for tracking employment and education enrollment for high risk adult offenders
- Use local alternatives to custody programs for probation youth

Updates

Redesigned the Alternative Report and Resource Center (ARRC) : ARRC 2.0 will bring in evidence based programming to address the needs of youth on Probation and provide services outside of the custodial setting in an effort to only detain youth that represent a risk to themselves or the community and or youth that are likely to flee the jurisdiction of the Juvenile Court. Further, ARRC 2.0 will assist Santa Barbara County Probation work toward reducing Racial and Ethnic Disparity by:

- Providing Alcohol and Drug Counselor at each geographical location
- Providing Re-Entry services for Los Prietos Boys Camp and Youth Offender Block Grant youth
- Providing Higher Education services for youth seeking to attend college
- Providing WAGESS for youth seeking employment
