### **Public Assistance Requested to Identify Bank Robbery Suspect**

**Goleta** — The Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office is requesting public assistance to help identify and locate the suspect who robbed a bank today, November 2, 2015, at the Fairview Shopping Center in the City of Goleta. Just before 11:30 a.m., the suspect entered the Union Bank branch located in the 200 block of N. Fairview Avenue. The suspect stood in line and waited for a bank teller. When it was his turn, he brandished a black colored semi-automatic handgun and demanded the bank teller fill a brown paper bag he brought with money from her drawer. The suspect left with an undisclosed amount of cash. He was last seen leaving the area in a dark colored, four-door sedan, possibly a Nissan, with paper license plates.

The suspect is described as a stocky, white male adult, 55 to 65 years of age, approximately 6'3" to 6'5" tall, with brown/grey hair, brown eyes and a brown/grey beard. He was wearing a dark Hawaiian shirt, black pants, a black baseball cap and eyeglasses.
