MRC Consent to Photograph

Purpose: To identify the procedure for photographing MRC exercise participants and/or patients treated in an MRC deployment.

Policy: Santa Barbara County Medical Reserve Corps Consent to Photograph Procedure.

Procedure or Policy:

MRC exercise participants and/or patients treated in an MRC deployment may be photographed for documentation, training, marketing or other organizational purposes. Prior to the archival and/or publication of photographs taken, consent to photograph will be obtained from photographed subjects.

Photographed subjects will be provided with the following written statement for review and signature:
